Summary Biography, May 1, 2018

Peter Kampa is a professional management consultant who specializes in strategies to assist rural local government agencies in providing cost effective public services for the long term. After spending a decade and a half of managing four different special districts in California, Mr. Kampa formed the consulting firm, Kampa Community Solutions, LLC in 2014 to offer small districts a competent, low cost alternative to the growing trend of constant management turnover. KampaCS currently provides general management services to five community services districts throughout the state.

Pete has spent 20 years this December as a member of the Board of Directors of the California Special Districts Association, serving on numerous committees and task forces focused on reducing the impact of bad legislation and regulation that ultimately reduce local services and increase cost. He has facilitated the planning, design and construction of over \$60 million in water and wastewater infrastructure upgrades, as well as park and trail construction.

Pete was selected as the statewide General Manager of the year in 2010, also receiving in the same year the Tuolumne County Excellence in Government award and achieving his Special District Administrator certification. Pete serves as an instructor for the Special District Leadership Foundation, training elected officials and managers on the practicalities of running a local government.

Mr. Kampa was contracted by the Groveland CSD to serve as Interim General Manager beginning in February 2018, and as of today, May 1, he assumes the role of regular General Manager.
